COST PLANNING FOR A CAMPAIGN

There is no way to estimate exactly to the dollar how much it would cost to host a campaign. We can give a close estimation.

- 1. <u>RV PARKING.</u> RV parking must be in keeping with the city codes and required permits. We do have equipment that can be used to build an electrical plant to take care of up to 30 units. They consist of 30/50 amps per RV. (See manual for more information on RV electrical) You will be responsible for paying the electrician to do the hook up. The cost will depend on how many units, etc. (Estimate cost \$2500.00).
- 2. <u>HOUSING FOR PERSONS WHO DRIVE IN BY CAR. OR PLANE.</u> The church will be responsible for housing workers from out of town and providing transportation to and from the building. This is of no cost to the congregation.
- 3. <u>ADVERTISING.</u> This expense <u>entirely depends on your decision</u> as to how much you are going to advertise the campaign in your area. (Radio, TV, Newspaper, fliers, etc.)
- 4. <u>STAFF MEMBERS.</u> We Care Staff members depend on outside support to continue this ministry so we ask the local congregation to cover their travel expenses. The size of the campaign will determine how many staff will be needed, but you can expect three to five staff members to travel to your congregation.
- 5. <u>FOOD BOXES</u>. The benevolent boxes are provided by the church that sponsors the campaign. Some churches will get their members involved in a food drive months before the deadline. This helps with the cost of the groceries. (Estimated \$ 40.00 per box times the number of boxes you wish to prepare).
- 6. <u>FEEDING ALL WORKERS.</u> If you are expecting 50 workers for the campaign, you will provide three meals each day for 10 days. We always start on Thursday and end on Sunday. You are not responsible for food for the two Saturday evenings. Estimate \$2.00 per plate times 3 meals = \$6.00 per person per day time 40 people = \$240.00 per day times 10 days =\$2400.00
- <u>7. CADRE MEMBERS.</u> Although our cadre will not receive any compensation for their work or expenses, as a courtesy, some churches will help defray their cost with some compensation for the use of their personal cars while campaigning. (**This is not mandatory**, rather just a suggestion).
- 8. <u>MATERIALS AND OFFICE</u>. You will receive the New Testaments and tracts from our office and will be billed accordingly. All left over material can be returned for credit, or you can give what if left to the evangelist who is preaching your campaign to be used for small church campaigns who cannot afford these luxuries. (Estimate cost \$2500.00). *There is no requirement to buy any other tracks from any other source for this campaign*.

9. COMPENSATION FOR WE CARE

Deposits & Fees are as follows; \$500.00 deposit (\$200 for small congregation under 100 members) payable to We Care Ministries upon commitment of campaign and \$1200.00 payable to We Care Ministries upon completion of campaign (*for large congregations only*). Note: In special circumstances WCM will wave the fees. WCM's goal is to win souls.

We do not charge for doing the campaigns but do expect expenses to be covered by the host congregation. If a small church of 50 to 100 will budget \$10,000 you will have a good campaign. Large churches needs \$20,000 budget.







We Care Crusade

"We're trying our best to get Christianity out of the building," says Larry West, the founder and evangelist for the national 'WE CARE' Ministries.

"We try to reach out and communicate that we care. It's one thing to say it, and another to show it." He says. "The world is full of sympathizers, but there are only a very few who really care, who really do something about it."

"While we're convinced Christ is the answer, He didn't promise to remove our problems. He's there for us to lean on.," he continues. "We're trying to be the 'Body of Christ'- intangible help. We're convinced people don't care how much you know until they know how much you care. Jesus demonstrated that. He fed the hungry." West observes.

West, a media evangelist from West Monroe, Louisiana will be speaking at the (insert place and date here) beginning at 7 each evening. This evangelist founded the WE CARE Ministries 29 years ago. WE CARE Ministries is an outreach of the White's Ferry Road church of Christ in West Monroe. He is a member and evangelist in that church.

West, a man with a pleasant voice and personable delivery has done daily radio programs carried by over 150 stations in 35 states. He also appeared in community service television spots speaking on family themes. He writes syndicated articles as well.

There is much more to the WE CARE Crusade than seven nights of preaching. The members give of their time and themselves. And they also give the offerings that make the program possible.

The members of the churches of Christ share the word of God through the gospel of giving. Part of their evangelistic thrust is showing those in need that they want to help.

Through its WE CARE Campaign, the church seeks out the needy; helps them survive, and also help them build a foundation on Christ.

"When the church helps people, it doesn't demand that they first come to church. When they leave, they understand that we want to discuss Jesus with them", West says.

The church of Christ has no denominational hierarchy. Each congregation is autonomous and operates under a governing board of elders.

West's WE CARE outreach staff will conduct 'Boot Camp' prior to the crusade to help train the area church members in ministering to the needy.

During the training sessions, the WE CARE Staff uses a 75-page manual in helping the local congregations organize their campaign. Nineteen committees are filled with volunteers from all the participating congregations.

"We try to develop an esprit de corps with our fellowship," West says. The church members are taught how to preach the gospel, as well as how to minister to everyday needs. The churches sometime try to help the needy find jobs or housing"

"We're saying, 'Look, let's love the Lord together," West says. "We'll pray a while, and love a lot. We're saying 'Hey, folks if you love God, if you need help; let us into your life—because WE CARE."

LARRY WEST

Practicing What He Preaches

Many have heard his radio messages, consisting of analytical once -upon-a-time stories depicting the lives and words of others. While the stories vary, the purpose is always the same, ending with the familiar phrase, "I'm Larry West, and I care".

One wonders what makes this caring man tick.

West, a media evangelist of 33 years will be in town this week as part of the We Care Ministries crusade, sponsored by the (Weatherford) church of Christ.

Crowds flock to the Community Center to see and hear the smooth-talking-yet-sincere man in person. It's likely that few are disappointed.

West has been involved with preaching campaigns for the past 30 years, traveling throughout 35 states, as well as Canada. His radio programs have been aired on some 125-radio stations for daily use, not as "pulpit pounders", he says.

"The purpose (of the radio programs) is to communicate that there's someone in the community who really cares for those who hurt," he said.

Unfortunately, according to West, there are very few people who care. He said, "The world is full of sympathizers, but there are very few who care. That's because caring is doing."

West believes that people need caring relationships. He claims that people have become so isolated in our society - locking doors, putting up fences - that there is no longer the traditional dependency on neighbors for help. Consequently, many are lost in our isolated society, alone in the crowd.

"What we're trying to do through the media is say look, we know you're hurting. But we care. Let us into your life," he said.

The "We care" campaigns started when West mentioned the phrase during one of his radio programs. The phrase "caught on," becoming part of the Church of Christ ministries.

Although he preached his first sermon at 14 years of age, West became interested in media ministry while at Abilene Christian University, in Abilene, Texas. Recognizing the influence Jesus had with his parables, West decided he could reach more people and enhance communication by delivering stories.

His main goal is to convey a clear message. "I don't want to stand in the way of the simple message of God's will," he noted.

So, what sets West apart from other evangelists?

"I believe, sincerely, with all my heart, that our doctrine is different," he said. "In our crusades, we try to present the will of the Father", he clarified. "That's how we call on the name of the Lord to be saved".

West added his belief that there are "too many creeds and not enough surrender, too much religion and not enough Christianity".

The "We Care" Church of Christ ministries are based in West Monroe, La., where West lives with his wife. He has two children and three grandchildren.

Although, the crusades are demanding time-wise, preventing West from spending all the time he'd like with his family, that doesn't detract from the way he feels about them.

"I love to preach, love to meet people and love to spread the truth of the gospel," he said, adding, "but I don't want to lose my family by trying to save the world".

West will be speaking at the (insert place and dates here).
