## Alternative questions for High Church, bottom-right box, flow chart

- 1. So, who taught you about God? Mother, father or perhaps an aunt?
- 2. Was that the person who gave you Catechism training, or was it the priest, or someone else?
- 3. What did you do first? Did you take communion first, or did you do confession in order to be able to take first communion?
- 4. At what age did you confirm your faith?
- 5. Can you share your experience with me? (Do it as if I were living it with you. I want to see it through your eyes and feel it with you. I care how you feel about it.)
- 6. (If you are talking with a lady; feelings are so much a part of it.) Do you still have your baptismal garments or first communion dress?
- 7. In your best understanding, where was the decisive moment of your getting right with God? Did your parents take care of the sin problem once and for all, or is it an ongoing relationship? Do you still confess your sins? Have you taken your priest's advice conscientiously and completed your penance?
- 8. Do you take advantage of every opportunity to go to mass? If so, what role do you play there?
- 9. Do you see God as distant in his involvement with us humans, or do you have more of a personal relationship with Him?
- 10. Are you encouraged to attend Bible class or other kind of study?
- 11. Have you any family in protestant services, or have you attended anywhere else? What was that like for you?
- 12. Are there any other special events that stand out in your mind that you are fond of, and you like to be a part of, on perhaps a yearly basis?
- 13. (Repeat his story so he can see how carefully you listened.) Let me see if I understand what you have told me.
- 14. Have you had any other conversion experiences?
